

The UN recently adopted a treaty which outlaws nuclear weapons internationally. 77% of the British public support this total ban on all nuclear weapons¹.

But the government said it won't sign it, and even announced a 44% increase in its nuclear stockpile.

This cannot stand.

Towns and cities around the world are bypassing their governments' opposition and becoming Nuclear Ban Communities as they declare their support for the treaty.

In the UK, Leeds, Edinburgh, Manchester, Oxford and Norwich among others have already backed the treaty.

SOME CONTEXT

The United Nations Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons (TPNW) became international law in January 2021.

The Treaty bans nuclear weapons in participating states and is generating international momentum towards global nuclear abolition.
