• Ambassador Jose Enrique Castillo Barrantes

has been Costa Rica's Ambassador to the UK since 2015. Previously he served as Minister of Foreign Affairs. He was a professor at Universidad de Costa Rica and is author of a number of works on international relations and law.

Brian Becker

is National Coordinator of the Answer Coalition, a United States anti-war and anti-racism organisation. Brian lives in Washington DC and is a commentator on US foreign affairs in the Middle East and Asia.

Huda Elmi

Jim Hoare

is a founder member of Iraqi Democrats. Sami was a political refugee from Saddam Hussein's regime. He is a *Guardian* contributor on the Middle East, and formerly a Senior Lecturer in sociology at London Metropolitan University.
